Overview

Year 13

Unit 2: The Music Industry
Unit 6: Solo Performance

Assessment method

Internally assessed for Units 1 and Unit 6. Externally assessed for Unit 3 and 2.

Additional information

Pupils will need to continue individual lessons on their chosen main instrument or voice.

Entry requirements

Five GCSE Grade 4 to 9. Students must be able to play an instrument or sing. Students require either a Btec Level 2 Music Performance or a GCSE Grade 4 in Music.
